

FONT INSTALLATION GUIDE

Installing OpenType OTF fonts on a Mac (OS X)

Your downloaded fonts will be contained inside a zipped archive. Before installing the fonts please ensure you expand the archive and unzip the fonts (double clicking on the .zip file should do the trick).

If using 3rd party font management software such as Suitcase or FontExplorer please refer to the user manual. If you want to use Apple's own Font Book application simply drag and drop your new fonts into the software program to activate them (or double click the font files and click 'Install Font' in the preview window).

If you'd prefer to install the fonts straight into the Mac OS you have 2 choices:

- directly into the System Fonts folder seen by everyone (Mac HD > Library > Fonts)
- or
- restrict to your personal folder (Mac HD > Users > YOUR ACCOUNT > Library > Fonts)

Installing OpenType fonts in Windows

Unzip the fonts contained in the .zip archive and extract them to a temporary location on your desktop (or other preferred location).

Right-click the font you want to install and click 'Install' or simply drag and drop the font into the Control Panel 'Fonts' folder.
